A joey or orphan kangaroo may look cute and cuddly but they require specialised food and care, and it is important that any injured or orphaned wildlife is handed to an experienced carer or vet as quickly as possible. Please do not attempt to feed the animal.

Stress is a major factor in poor outcome for captured wildlife, so it is most important to keep the animal warm, dark and quiet.

Keep away from other animals and young children.

Contact the 24 hour hotline immediately for advice on the next step.

Under section 17 of the *Animal Care and Protection Act 2001*, a person in charge of an animal during its rescue, care, rehabilitation or release has a statutory duty of care to appropriately provide for the animal's welfare.
